RUN:

The run is an out and back course along Chandler Blvd. The runners will be running in the shadows of all the beautiful lights. Both walkers and runners are welcome to participate. During the run, the participants will encounter two festive stations. One will be a chocolate station, and a peppermint station. Water is also available at each station. There will be a jingle bell bracelet station at the start line.

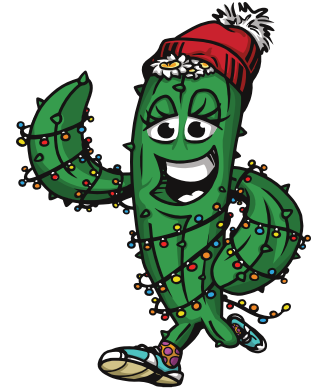

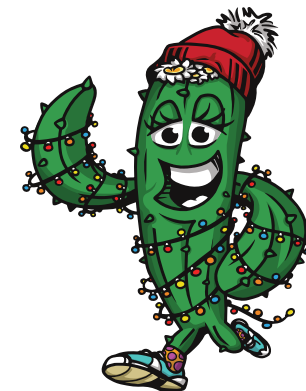
